Subject: Loop Link Construction Project

Hello Businesses, Residents, Property Owners, Tenants and other Stakeholders,

Here is the update for the week:

WASHINGTON STREET

The Loop Link construction proceeds on Washington. Pavement removal and excavation moves forward between Wacker and LaSalle. New pavement has already been completed between Franklin and Wells. It is anticipated that more new pavement will be completed in the next week.

Traffic signal improvements on Washington are under way.

MADISON STREET

Pavement removal has started on Madison Street between Wabash & State.

Reinforcing steel for the platform between State and Dearborn was delivered. Work on this platform will start soon.

CLINTON STREET

The construction on Clinton also moves forward with traffic signal and sidewalk repairs at various locations.

UNION STATION TRANSPORTATION CENTER

Work is now under way for the new Union Station Transportation Center. Lane reductions are in effect on Jackson (west of Canal) and Canal (south of Jackson).

OTHER NOTES

Enforcement of no parking and tow zone areas will be increased in the next couple of weeks. Please obey all posted signs.
