**Subject: Loop Link Construction Project**

Hello Businesses, Residents, Property Owners, Tenants and other Stakeholders,

Here is the update for the week:

**WASHINGTON STREET**

The Loop Link work will commence on the two blocks from Clark to State, starting early Tuesday, May 26. Traffic will be restricted to the two north curb lanes only. The existing CTA bus stop at near side Dearborn will remain unchanged for the time being. Parking restrictions on these two blocks will be strictly enforced.

The new red, CTA bus only, pavement was completed between Wells and LaSalle. It is anticipated that pavement removal operations will commence next week between Clark and State.

Traffic signal improvements on Washington continue.

**MADISON STREET**

There will be complete night time closures of Madison, from State to Wells, next week due to utility work. These closures will start on Tuesday night, May 26 and run for five consecutive nights.

Construction of the new pavement on Madison Street between Wabash and State was completed in one week! The right turn lane onto northbound State has been reopened.

Reinforcing steel for the platform between State and Dearborn was delivered. Work on this platform will begin this week.

**CLINTON STREET**

The construction on Clinton continues with traffic signal and sidewalk repairs at various locations.

**UNION STATION TRANSPORTATION CENTER**

The construction work for the new Union Station Transportation Center is moving forward. Lane reductions are in effect on Jackson (west of Canal) and Canal (south of Jackson).

**OTHER NOTES**

The Department of Water Management and AT&T will be starting on repairs to two structures on LaSalle Street next week. The work impacts southbound LaSalle at Randolph and northbound LaSalle at Washington. There will be lane reductions at the Washington location.

Enforcement of no parking and tow zone areas will be increased in the next couple of weeks particularly on Washington at Clark and Washington at Dearborn.
